



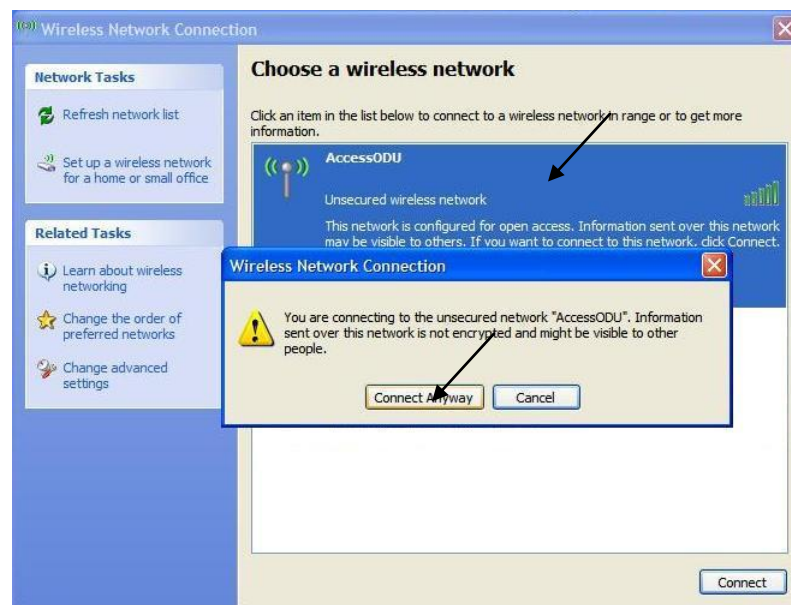
# Connecting to Old Dominion University “AccessODU” Wireless Network Windows XP (SP2) Users

## Configuring the Wireless Network Connection Properties

1. Be sure the wireless NIC is turned on and the most current drivers are installed on your computer.
2. Click inside the ***bubble*** that appears like shown below.



3. Select the ***AccessODU*** network and click ***Connect***. Click ***Connect Anyway*** on the pop-up window that appears.

**Acceptable Usage Policy**

Old Dominion University's "AccessODU" wireless network is an unencrypted wireless network for the use by authorized clients only. Individuals using the wireless network system are subject to having all their activity on this computer network system monitored and recorded by system personnel.
